NRA 1000 YARD LONG RANGE HIGH POWER RIFLE MATCH

- DATE:** July 22nd 2017
- TIME:** Registration Opens at 7:00 am Saturday
Registration Closes at 7:45 am Saturday
Firing Begins Saturday at 8:00am
- LOCATION:** Worland, Wyoming at the Worland Shooting Complex Rifle Range, alongside of fifteen mile road, (Next to the Land Fill)
Call or e-mail for directions.
- ENTRIES:** Advance entry registration is strongly recommended, but not required. Registrations will be accepted by calling Nick at 307 347- 8852, or e-mail scarecrow45@rtconnect.net. Entries are limited to 36 shooters.
- ELIGIBILITY:** Any individual familiar with safe firearms practices, and who supports the right of the citizens to keep and bear arms is welcome. All competitors are encouraged to be members of the NRA and the WSSA but it's not required. New shooters are welcome!
Competitors must be legally eligible to use firearms.
- MATCH FEES:** Adults, 25.00
Juniors and Active Duty Military shoot for free.
- CLASSIFICATION:** The NRA High Power Rifle Classifications system will be used. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class unless otherwise assigned or allowed by current NRA rules
- RULES:** Current NRA High Power, Long Range Rifle Rules will govern. Use of an "Empty Chamber Indicator" is required, and maybe purchased for \$2.00 at registration.
- RIFLES:** Any Rifle (rule 3.2) Match Rifle (rule 3.3) Service Rifle (Rule 3.1) Palma Rifle (Rule 3.3.1) Tactical Rifle (Rule 3.3.2) F Class Rifle Open (rule 3.4 a) F Class Target Rifle (rule 3.4 b){Special Category} Hunter Class Rifle Under14.5lbs Including Sights & optional Bipod
- SAFETY** Caliber limited to .33 or less. No muzzle breaks allowed. Assistance and coaching allowed until first shot for record. Unlimited sighting shots are allowed, but all shots must be taken within the 25 minute time allowed. Hearing and Eye protection is required to compete in the match.
- MATCH DUTIES:** All matches will be squadded, and competitors will be expected to score, and perform pit duties.
- AMMUNITION:** Any Safe Ammo, except tracer or incendiary
- POSITIONS:** PRONE, & PRONE with rest, The rifle must be fired from the shoulder.

TARGETS: Rule 4.7 LR, 1000yds. & F-Class, 1000yds LRFC.

CATEGORIES:

1. Any rifle iron sights
2. Any rifle scope sights
3. Service Rifle
4. F Class Rifle Open
5. F Class Target Rifle
6. (Special Category) Hunter Class Rifle, (under 14.5 lbs, including sights and optional bipod, fired from rest) Special Category scores will not be forwarded to the NRA

AWARDS: Cash and certificate awards as appropriate.
Awards “may” be given for all individual matches. Categories may be combined if fewer than 3 competitors in a category. Awards by NRA class possible, and the Classes combined if fewer than 3 in a class. If fewer than 6 High Masters, they will compete for Match Overall Winner Award only.

COURSE OF FIRE: 60 shots of record fire as described. Unlimited sighting shots are allowed, but all shots must be taken within the 25 minute time.

“Three” - 1,000 yd. Individual Matches.

Match/Event One: 25min, Unlimited sighters, 20 shots for record

Match/Event Two: 25min, Unlimited sighters, 20 shots for record

Match/Event Three: 25min, Unlimited sighters, 20 shots for record.

Note: 25min, Unlimite sighters, Only 10 shots for record for special hunter class

Nice to Know Info: Free cool water, but Bring your own food and small snack items To eat during the matches. Dry Camping is available on the range. (No electric or sewer hookup)
